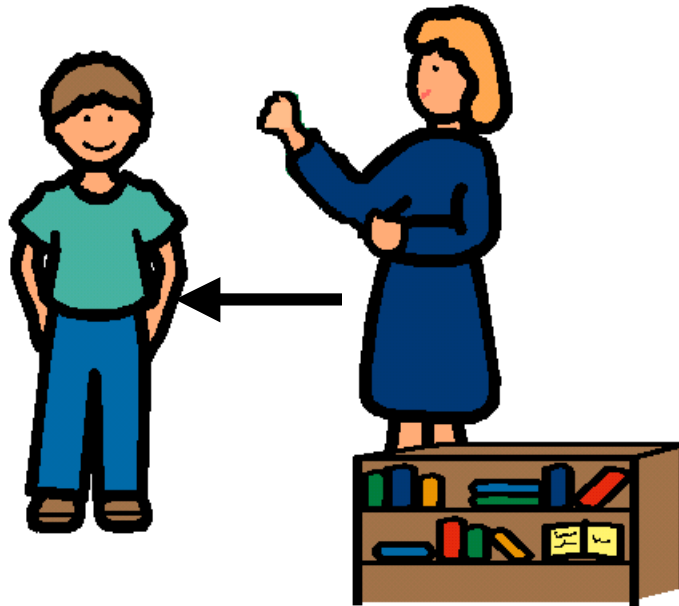

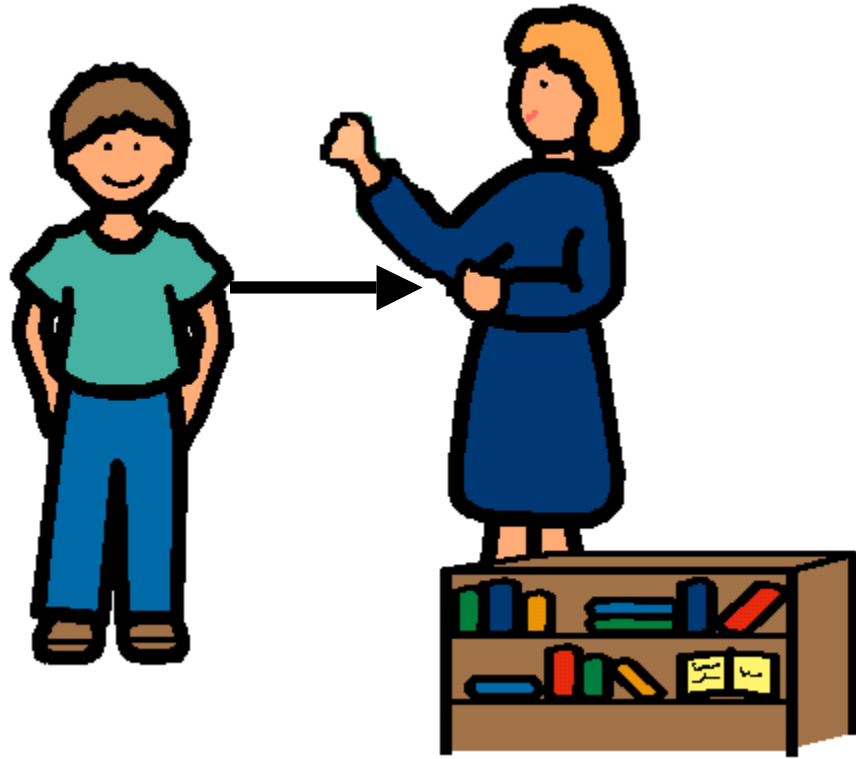
Most people like to be with others.




When I am at school, I am with my teacher.



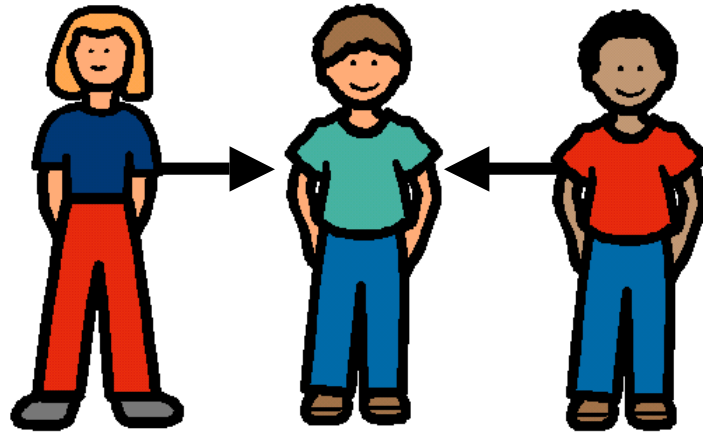
When a teacher talks with me, she stands about the length of an arm away.  A teacher usually does not stand too close to me.



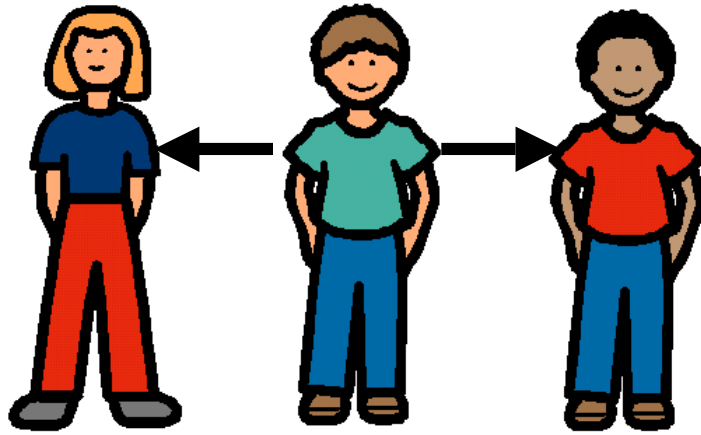
When I talk with a teacher, I should try to stand about an arm's length  away too.

When I talk with other kids, I should try to stand about an arm's length away too.

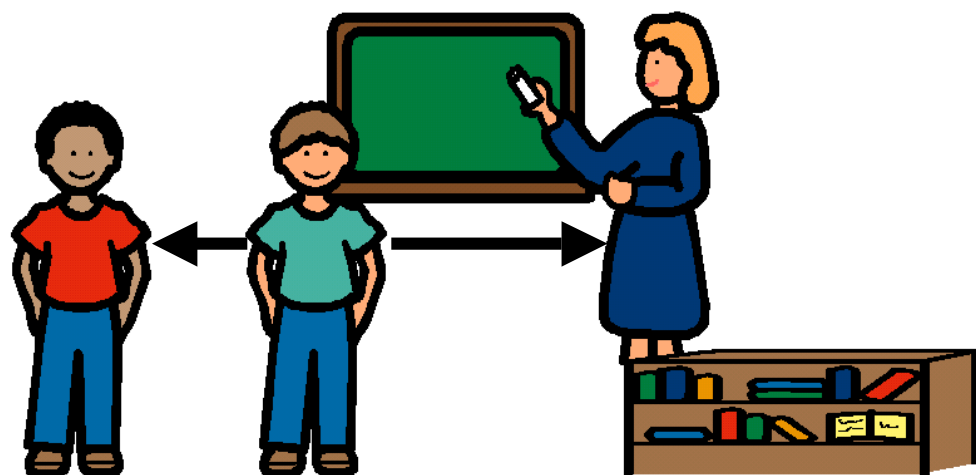




If I stand too close, I am in the personal space of other kids. Kids don't like it if I am in their personal space.
